## Experience of Tea Ceremony at Izumi Shrine



Feel the Japanese culture through Tea Ceremony at the tearoom or the traditional Japanese “Tatami” room in Izumi Shrine.

### Experience:

- Course A: Making and having tea. Learning from the students of a school tea ceremony club, you make powdered green tea by yourselves and have it.
- Course B: Having tea. Students of the tea ceremony club serve you tea and show you the manners of tea ceremony.

### Participants:

- Course A&B

Foreign visitors will be served first. (Japanese are also welcome.)

The students will conduct everything in English.

### Capacity:

- Course A: One to 16 people at one time
- Course B: One to four people at one time

### Schedule:

May 4 (Saturday) and May 5 (Sunday), 2019

- Course A: Registration 10:00~15:00 (It will take about 45 minutes to take course A.)
- Course B: Registration 10:00~15:00 (It will take about 30 minutes to take course B.)

\* You might wait for a while if there are many participants.

\* For course A, some groups might join the program together.

### Place:

- Course A : 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Izumi Shrine office
- Course B : “Suigetsu-tei” , tea ceremony room inside Izumi Shrine office

\* You can register for the experience at any time in front of the shrine office.

\* We will provide chairs for persons who cannot sit on their heels.
